**Schedule A 1**



Conditions for students enrolled at the Augsburg University of Applied Sciences (Hochschule Augsburg), Faculty of Business, to obtain the IAE Montpellier diploma (Licence).

Double degree certification is possible for all students of the Faculty of Business satisfy the following conditions:

1. The 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year at the University of Augsburg Applied Sciences must have been completed successfully in the study course Bachelor International Management. (120ECTS)  
The IAE Montpellier will admit students to their 'premier cycle' on the provision of an academic transcript for 120 ECTS credits.
2. During the fifth and sixth semester students will study the first-year, Licence programme (see appendix A1), of the IAE Montpellier, (third study year).  
Accreditation of subjects, towards the Licence programme, is possible, at the discretion of the IAE Montpellier, to the amount of 20% of study load (12 ECTS), provided a student has achieved additional credits beyond the 120 mentioned above.
3. On successfully completing the Licence programme, including a report de stage according to IAE regulations, the IAE Montpellier will award the degree '**Licence Management des Sciences & Technologies**'.
4. Subjects of the above mentioned Licence programme will need to be passed in order to be accredited\*.  
Accreditation of a successfully completed Licence programme for the degree at the AUAS, is at the discretion of the exam's commission of the Faculty of Business (see appendix A2)
5. In order to fulfil the requirements of the IAE Licence degree, students will have to undertake their placement directly following their final examinations at the IAE. This placement shall also be accredited towards their Bachelor degree at the AUAS providing it fulfils AUAS exam's commission criteria.
6. During the seventh semester students will study at the AUAS for their Bachelor thesis and remaining credits to complete their degree.

- \*Subjects which have not been passed individually (even if the overall grading for the IAE degree might be a pass) , may be retaken (rattrapage) and certified, once only (May and/or September), at the discretion of the IAE
