Rules of thumb for applying

The application period for restricted-admission bachelor's programs (known as NC programs) runs from May 2 to July 15. For bachelor's programs without admission restrictions or with aptitude tests, as well as master's programs, please note the deadline for the respective program.

The deadlines also apply to applications for a higher semester.

The university entrance qualification or preliminary review documentation (for foreign applicants) can be submitted by July 27 or January 30 at the latest.

For bachelor's programs without admission restrictions or with aptitude tests, as well as for master's programs, the specific deadline for the respective program applies.

For part-time degree programs, some different application deadlines apply.

Online application

Online applications are only possible during the respective application period via the online portal of the Technical University of Applied Sciences Augsburg. You must also submit any additional documents via the online portal.

hochschulstart.de - Stiftung für Hochschulzulassung

Admission to NC degree programs in the first semester is carried out exclusively via the dialogue-oriented service procedure (DoSV) of the Stiftung für Hochschulzulassung. For most NC bachelor's degree programs at the Technical University of Applied Sciences Augsburg, study places are therefore allocated via the allocation procedure of hochschulstart.de.



HOW TO FIND YOUR DEGREE PROGRAM!

Tips from our Central Student Advisory Service on choosing your degree program:

- Allow enough time! Choosing your degree program is a learning process, so make sure you get all the information you need in good time.
- Be clear about what you actually want and where your strengths lie! Think about what drives you and what interests you.
- 3. Gather information and find out about the admission requirements! Do you need internships, language tests, or professional experience in advance? Is your degree program restricted? Do you have a university entrance qualification for German universities? Have you already submitted preliminary review documentation (Vorprüfungsdokumentation VPD) to uni-assist e.V.?
- Pay attention to application deadlines!
 Check the THA website to find out when you can apply for your desired degree program.
- Use study choice aids! Take study choice tests, visit study fairs, and attend information events. The THA always holds its big study orientation day in the spring, and there are also a variety of information events throughout the year.

- Don't be afraid to ask questions! The THA has a student advisory service that can help you with any questions you may have about studying at the THA.
- The proof of the pudding is in the eating!
 Do an internship and gain some professional experience. Ask your parents, acquaintances, and friends about their experiences.
- 8. Clarify the general conditions! How expensive is a degree program? How will you finance it?
- 9. Take a look at the THA! Do you like the city? Do you feel at home on our campus?


