Residence permit / Visa	Compulsory for Non-EU/EEA students. For more information visit : http://www.eda.admin.ch/eda/en/home.html An invitation letter will be sent by the Office MOVE. Do not book the flight before obtaining the visa ! (6 to 12 weeks delay) Students are not able to enter Switzerland without a valid visa !
Right to reside	Compulsory for all students. To apply for at local municipality within the first week of arrival to get the residence permit
Language requirement	For courses taught in French, German or English for the Tourism degree and Business Information Systems degree: B2 level is required but C1 level is recommended
