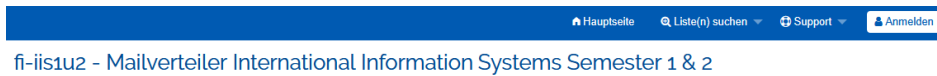

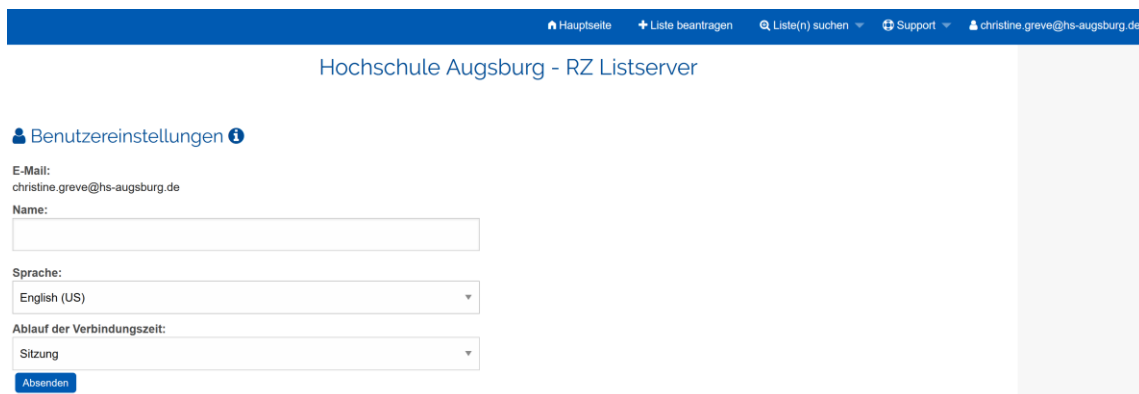
Click on the list (fi-iis1u2@hs-augsburg.de).

Then choose on the left side "Abonnieren / Subscribe" and fill in your name. To confirm your request, please click the button (ich abonniere die Liste fi-iis1u2 / I subscribe to list fi-iis 1u2). After then „bestätigen/confirm“ again.

Campus Card

Student card, semester ticket, library card, payment card, access card

The Campus Card Augsburg is the student ID card of Technical University of Applied Sciences Augsburg in the form of a multifunctional chip card.

Before you can use the Campus Card Augsburg for the first time, you must validate it at one of the stations provided.

Locations of the validation stations (see map on last page):

- Campus am Roten Tor

in the foyer to lecture halls M 1.01 and M 1.02

- Campus am Brunnenlech

in the foyer of the library, H-building, ground floor

Validate your Campus Card as soon as possible, otherwise you will not have a valid ticket for public transport!

In case of problems with the Campus Card, e.g. swiping in the validation machine, chip card defective, theft, loss, etc., please contact the Service Office of the IT Services Center:

Lecture halls

Leave the rooms as you would like to find them.

If necessary, use the waste paper baskets provided.

Manipulation - even temporarily - of the wiring of devices/tables in the lecture halls is strictly prohibited!

Use of the laboratories (computer labs, etc.)

Please observe the laboratory regulations!

Eating in the lab rooms is not permitted! Drinking in the labs is tolerated, but no vessels (cups, mugs, bottles) are allowed on the computer tables.

during normal opening hours:

outside normal opening hours:

Students of the Faculty of Computer Science have the option of activating their Campus Cards for access to the faculty buildings, lecture halls and laboratories if they wish to use them outside normal opening hours.
