Grading System

All exchange students can take 2 credits ~ 18 credits per semester.

1 Credit = 16 teaching hours including lectures, exam, assignments, and attendance



1 Course = 2 or 3 credits

Each course lasts a semester(16 weeks).

 Two male students occupy for room 2






<Architecture Plan>

Number of exchanges students

Due to accommodation and course registration issue, SeoulTech decided to implement a strategic enrollment limitation from 2024 academic year. This move is driven by our commitment to maintaining high standard of education, fostering a conducive learning environment, and ensuring that each of students received personalized attention and support from SeoulTech. We will try to maintain the number of inbound and outbound exchange students. If SeoulTech students haven't joined your exchange program in the last two semesters, we will offer only **1(one)** open seat for partner university. Please note that we are not able to accept more than **2(two)** students from each of partner universities per semester. **If you are uncertain about the quota, we highly recommend you to contact SeoulTech in advance before beginning your selection process.**



Application procedure

- Nomination deadline (Online Application) *subject to change
- Spring semester(Mar to Jun): 15th October / Fall semester(Sep to Dec): 15th April
- Application deadline (Online Application) *subject to change
- Spring semester(Mar to Jun): 31st October / Fall semester(Sep to Dec): 30th April
- Application documents
- 1st: A copy of passport, Study Plan, Recommendation Letter, Official transcript
- 2nd: Health clearance(TB test Result), Flight info, Copy of Korea visa
- ** Additional documents(only students from None OECD countries): A certificate of bank statement(balance) / A certificate of enrollment of current home university notarized by the Korea embassy or Apostilled.

Language requirement

SEOULTECH requires a good knowledge of **English (B2 level)** to communicate and function in an academic context.

-An internationally acknowledged language certificate equal to the B2 level are required

; TOEIC 750/ IELTS 5.5/ TOEFL 72 /Cambridge English Scale 160 / Global Scale of English (Pearson) 59

Insurance

National Health Insurance is a mandatory policy implemented by the Ministry of Health and Welfare in Korea; it is not optional. It applies regardless of whether you have private insurance. Once your foreign registration is completed after arriving in Korea, your information will be updated in the National Health Insurance system, and you will be automatically enrolled.

Visa

A student visa (D-2-6) is required to study in Korea if a student is not of Korean nationality. Be aware that students cannot change their visitor visa to a student visa in Korea. Students should apply for a student visa (D-2-6). The ministry of justice launched a now regulations as of June, 2022 and strengthened a immigration policy. They require additional materials for exchange students from Non-OECD countries.

- * Students from OECD countries: Normally the three documents(Ceertificate of admission, Acceptance letter, Certificate of business registration) will be sufficient to apply for a student visa.(D-2-6)
- * Students from Non-OECD countries: The ministry of Justice strengthened an immigration policy and requires additional materials even for exchange students.
 - A certificate of bank statement(balance): The bank statement should cover your exchange study semester living cost.(USD 4,000 for one semester/ USD 8,000 for one academic year).



- A certificate of enrollment: It should be Apostilled or notarized by the embassy of Korea in student's study country.
